

WHEREAS: By invading Cambodia and resuming the bombing of North Vietnam, the Nixon Administration has once again violated the principle of separation of powers, and has thus violated the Constitution itself, and

WHEREAS: This extension of the undeclared war is not only unconstitutional, but constitutes a serious breach of faith with the American People, on the basis of which there are efforts being made in Congress to ~~in~~ impeach the President,

WHEREAS: By the President's own admission on May 1 the majority of our nation is against the war in Southeast Asia, and

WHEREAS: The vast national resources expended on this unconstitutional adventure are desperately needed for the solution of our grave domestic problems,

WHEREAS: Legitimate dissent has been met with a nationwide wave of repression, the most recent example of which is the murder by the national guard of four students at Kent State, and

WHEREAS: Governor Reagan's attempt to coopt the student strike movement by declaring the campuses closed on May 7 and 8 is only one more in a series of efforts to stifle sincere student initiative to deal constructively and peacefully with all the above problems be it ~~it~~ therefore

RESOLVED: That the Associated Students Council declare San Diego State College on-strike until such time as tangible steps have been taken to meet the following demands:

1. Withdraw all United States Troops and material from Southeast Asia immediately and unconditionally.
2. Free all such political prisoners as Reis Tijerina, Bobby Seale, Ericka Huggins and other Black Panthers, Chicago Conspiracy Eight, and the thousands of draft and G. I. resisters.
3. Stop using colleges and universities to sustain United States aggression; and military recruiting, research, and training on campus.
4. Withdraw permanently all National guardsman and policemen from every American campus (whose presence has resulted in the recent murder of _____)
5. The immediate ending of the San Diego State Air ~~Force~~ ROTC program.
6. Immediately end all war related contracts between the United States Government and San Diego State College.
