Lt.(jg) Joseph Mitchael Suozzo, 24, of 2472 Capitan Ave., in San Diego,
winner of the Silver Star medal, was released from the Navy yesterday at the
Naval Personnel Separation Center in Los Angeles.

A graduate of S.D. State College, Suozzo entered the Navy in January 1942,
an
and became/officer in the Amphibious forces serving in both the European and
Pacific theaters of operation. Suozzo was decorated with the Silver Star for
the part he played in the Normandie Invasion. He was skipper of an LCT(A) which was
struck by enemy shore fire as she raced for the beach at "H" Hour. Although
the craft was badly damaged and almost out of control, Suozzo skillfully man-
euvered her safely through a large number of anti-landing craft obstacles, and
landed his urgently needed cargo consisting of one Sherman tank, on the
beach-head.
